Within the Framework of the Campaign of Hizb ut Tahrir / Wilayah Sudan to Foil the Plan of Separating Darfur

The Members of Hizb ut Tahrir in the City of Al-Obeid Address a Fervent Call to the Muslims at Al-Obeid Grand Mosque and Carry Banners in Another Activity at the Transportation Station

In two separate activities, the shabab (members) of Hizb ut Tahrir in the city of Al-Obeid, on Saturday 06/09/2025, and within the framework of the campaign organized by Hizb ut Tahrir / Wilayah Sudan to foil the plan of tearing Sudan apart by separating Darfur, and considering that the unity of the Ummah is a vital issue regarding which the measure is life or death, the shabab of Hizb ut Tahrir in Al-Obeid, in the first activity, addressed a fervent call to the Muslims in their various categories: politicians, media professionals, scholars, officers, and soldiers, calling upon them to perform their Shari' obligation towards preventing the secession of Darfur. This was at Al-Obeid Grand Mosque, and the call was read by Ustadh al-Nadhir Muhammad Hussein, member of the Council of Hizb ut Tahrir in Wilayah Sudan. The attendees interacted with the call in a manner that confirmed this Ummah's love for Islam and its da'wah carriers.

As for the second activity, the shabab of the Hizb carried out a stand in front of the screen at the bus station in the middle of the market, carrying banners urging people to work to foil the American plan aiming to tear Sudan apart by detaching Darfur. Passersby interacted with positive comments and by taking photos, which disturbed one of the police officers, who demanded the dispersal of the stand, after it had already achieved its purpose.
