**Arous ar-Rimal Interacts with the Activities of the Dawah Week
for the Resumption of the Islamic Way of Life
Held by Hizb ut Tahrir / Wilayah Sudan**

During the period from Sunday 19/11/2017 until Thursday, 24/11/2017, Hizb ut Tahrir / Wilayah Sudan, set up in Al-Obaid City, the capital of North Kordofan, and the city of Arous ar-Rimal, [the activities of the Dawah week](#) for the resumption of the Islamic way of life under the banner: "The Great Islam ...
